

University Enrollment

This fall, DePaul enrolled 21,348 total students, up from 20,917 in fall 2022. Undergraduate enrollment accounts for 67% of total enrollment, compared with 64% in 2019. Graduate enrollment accounts for 30% of university enrollment, and law accounts for 3% of university enrollment.
